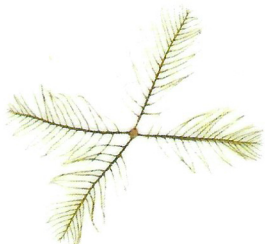


Eurasian water-milfoil (*Myriophyllum spicatum*)



Leaves in whorls of 3-5.
In late summer, the distance
between the whorls may be
several inches.



More than 12 pairs of leaflets.

- Delicate feather-like leaves. Leaflets are mostly the same length.
- Leaves are usually limp when out of the water.
- Long reddish brown spaghetti-like stems.
- Flower stalks, when present, stick up above the water.
- No winter buds.
- Prefers water depths of 3' to 14'.
