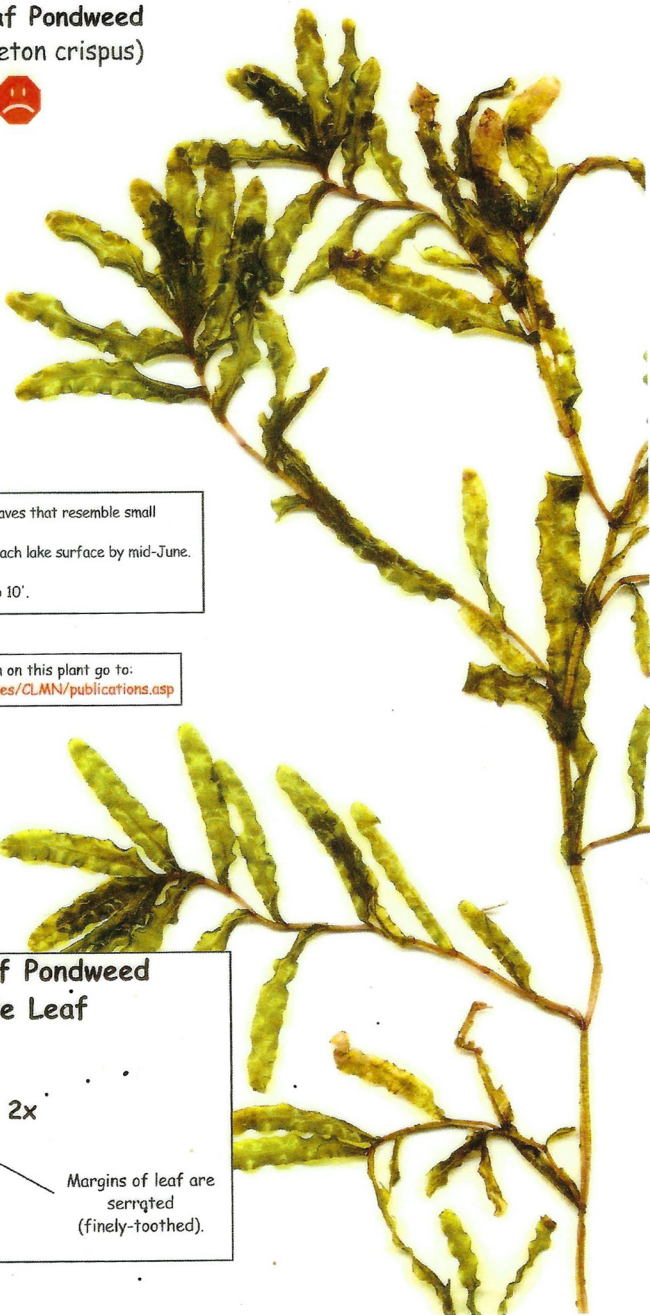


Curly-leaf Pondweed (*Potamogeton crispus*)



Vegetative buds ("turions") resemble small brown pine cones. Actual size 1-2 cm.



- Submersed plant with wavy leaves that resemble small lasagna noodles.
- Spaghetti-like stems often reach lake surface by mid-June.
- Leaf texture is crispy.
- Prefers water depths of 3' to 10'.
